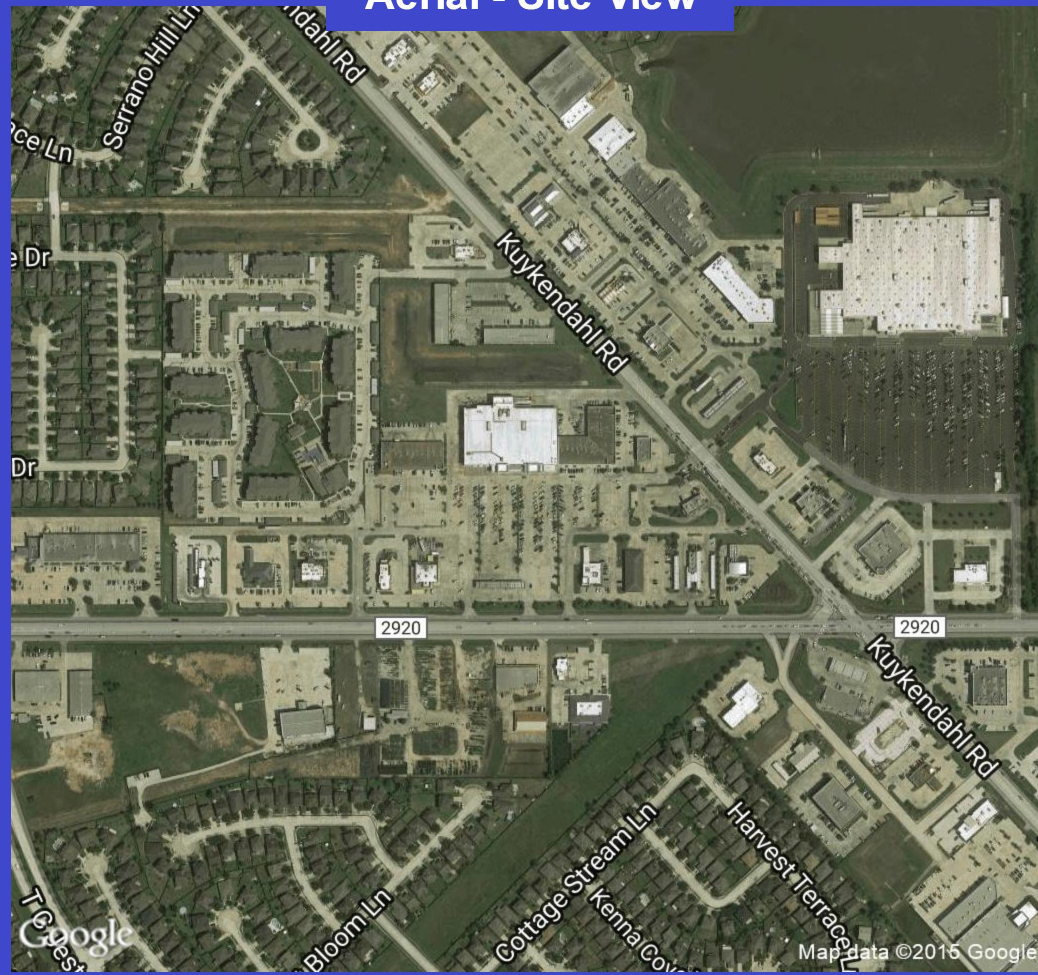
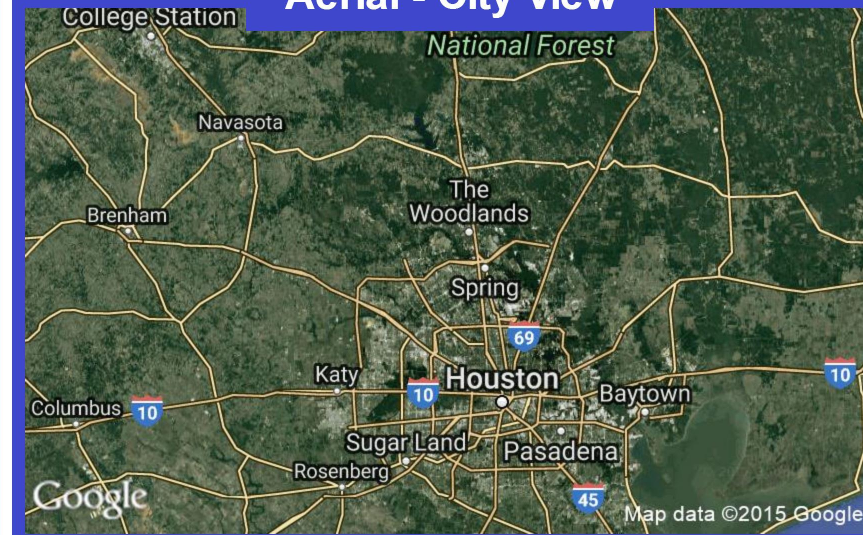


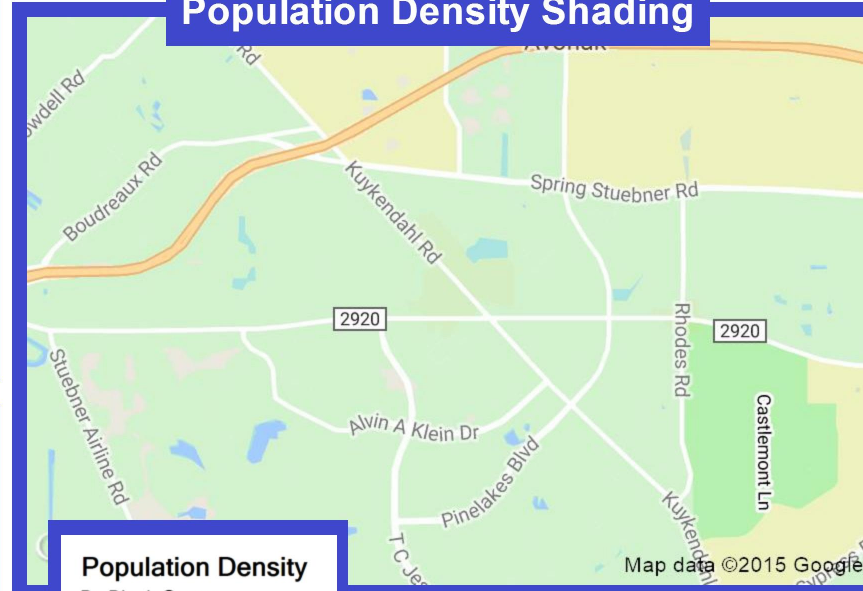
Aerial - Site View
